

# Marquette Catholic Dress Code

## 2008 – 2009

At Marquette Catholic High School we seek to maintain an atmosphere that is conducive to the highest quality of academic pursuit. Since the appearance of students contributes greatly to their attitude in school and the respect they earn in public, all students are expected to follow the dress code. Clothing is to be in good taste – not distracting.

### **SHIRTS:**

Collared shirts. Any color, any pattern, long or short sleeve, no wording (except for Blazerwear). Shirts must be tucked into trousers, pants, shorts or capris.

### **TROUSERS/PANTS/CAPRI'S (No Jeans):**

Any pattern, any solid color except white. Must be worn at waist. No cargos or tight-fitting pants/capris. No leggings.

### **SHORTS:**

Any knee-length pattern or any solid color except white.

### **SWEATERS:**

Any color, any pattern, any style. A collared shirt must be worn under sweater.

### **SWEATSHIRTS:**

Only Blazerwear sweatshirts are allowed on Fridays.

### **FOOTWEAR:**

School shoes or gym shoes. All shoes must be closed toe.

### **EARRINGS (Ladies):**

No more than two piercings per ear. Hoops are to be no longer than a quarter.

### **EARRINGS (Gentlemen):**

No earrings are permitted.

### **BELTS:**

Leather or leather-type are to be worn with all bottoms that have belt loops.

### **HAIR (Ladies):**

Hair is to be clean and well-groomed. Any style or coloring that would draw undue attention to a student is not permitted.

### **HAIR (Gentlemen):**

Hair is to be clean and well-groomed. Hair is not to extend below the top of the collar and cut above the eye brow line. Any style or coloring that would draw undue attention to a student is not permitted. Sideburns may not extend below the earlobe. Facial hair of any kind is not permitted.

### **\*Please note that the following items are not to be worn:**

Jeans or any denim like material. Sleeveless clothing. Clothing with wording, except Blazerwear which is allowed only on Fridays. Short shorts/skirts/dresses. No sandals, flip-flops, beach wear or open-toed footwear. No cargo pants/shorts. No drooping or over-sized clothing. No low-riding trousers/slacks/shorts/skirts. No excessively tight-fitting clothing. No t-shirts except Blazerwear which is allowed on Fridays. No body piercing jewelry (nose studs, tongue studs, rings, etc.). No tattoos. Fleece wear jackets (including knit jackets) and coats are not to be worn. No hats/caps.
