The following rules and regulations have been set forth by the IHSAA and host Triton High School. The regulations set forth in the IHSAA 2009-2010 Fall Bulletin shall apply.

1. Tickets-Admission

The admission fee shall be \$5.00 for each session. Season tickets will sell for \$8.00 each.

Each participating school is provided 22 complimentary tickets for players, managers, athletic trainers, administrators, etc. These tickets are non-transferable.

There is no charge for pre-school age children.

Doors will open one hour before the start of the first game. TEAMS WILL BE ADMITTED a half hour before the doors opens to the public.

No pass outs will be allowed.

2. Ball

The Molten IV58L will be used for the tournament. Teams should provide their own practice balls.

3. Cheerleaders

Cheerleaders and their sponsor(s) must have a ticket to enter a tournament series contest. Only cheerleaders from the two participating schools may be used. They shall use only that portion of the floor which is immediately in front of their fans and shall remain outside the boundary lines at all times while the match is in progress.

*The decisions of the officials are final and protests arising from the decisions of the officials or any inadvertent misinterpretation or misapplication of the rules will not be considered by the IHSAA.

5. Locker Rooms

Locker rooms will be assigned upon team's arrival. Triton High School is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

6. Scorer/Libero Tracker

Triton will provide the official scorer and libero tracker. Teams that are playing will have a space available behind the scorer's table.

7. Warm-Ups

The total warm-up time shall be 15 minutes prior to each match and exclusive of match preliminaries conducted by officials, announcements, etc. Each team shall be limited to 7 1/2 minutes with the home team warming up outside the court. The procedure is then reversed for the second 7 1/2 minutes.

8. Awards

Awards will be provided by the IHSAA. Sectional winners will receive an IHSAA Sectional Champion trophy and game ball. Runner-up will receive a game ball.

9. Parking

Parking will be available in the parking lots located south and west of the gym.

10. Hospitality Room

A hospitality room will be provided for coaches and administrators from participating schools.

11. Seating

There will be no reserved seats. The tournament director will assign seating. All fans are expected to sit in their designated area. We will have the top and bottom bleachers on one side available for seating. We ask that when your team is not playing you move to the top section to allow adequate space for fans whose teams are playing.

*Administrators from the participating schools who are playing will be expected to help police their fans.

12. Concessions

Concessions will be sold for all sessions.

13. Photographers

Flash pictures are not to be taken. Photographers should make arrangements with the host school.
*Photographers may use electronic flash/strobe cameras.
**Each school may have 1 student-photographer floor pass.

14. News Media

Please notify your local news media and have them contact Mason McIntyre, Athletic Director at Triton Jr./Sr. High School for media credentials.

15. Videotaping

Only the two participating schools may videotape their game. Parents may videotape their child's game as long as it does not interfere with other spectators. Parents may be asked to move to designated areas if problems occur.

16. Restrictions

Each principal should inform students and adult fans of the following restrictions:

- A. Balloons, banner, shakers on sticks, and/or posters are not permitted.
- B. Cowbells and other such noise making devices are not allowed.
- C. The use of pep bands at all levels of the tournament is permitted.
- D. No live animal mascots are permitted.
- E. Line-up lanes of fans shall not be permitted on the playing floor at any time.

17. Introduction of Players

We will introduce all the players on each team every game of the tournament, beginning with the reserve players. The National Anthem will be played for the first game of the evening.

18. Postponement

In the event of inclement weather, the decision to postpone the tournament will be made by Triton High School and the tournament director after consulting with the principals of the participating schools. Same tickets will be used in case of a make-up date.

19. Financial Terms

Tournament expenses such as officials, help, etc., shall be paid by the center school from the gross receipt.
