



Anita F. Boorda Scholarship for the Performing Arts (Application due Monday, March 1, 2022)

The Anita F. Boorda Scholarship for the Performing Arts aims to support high school seniors who plan to pursue a degree in Performing Arts, Music, Theatre, Dance or Production.

ELIGIBILITY

Students must:

- be a resident of St. Joseph, Elkhart, Marshall, Kosciusko, Fulton, Pulaski, Starke or LaPorte Counties in Indiana or Berrien or Cass Counties in Michigan;
- graduate with a minimum G.P.A. of 2.5 (4.0 scale) from an accredited high school by June 30 of the year of application;
- plan to attend an accredited tax-exempt college or university to pursue a degree in Performing Arts, Music Theatre, Dance or Production through a full-time course of study;
- Preference will be given to students engaged in the performing arts during their high school career.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Complete the Performing Arts Eligibility Quiz 2022 found online at: <https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cfsjcscholarship>
 - You will first need to create an account through the system. Then, navigate to the “Apply” page and you will see a list of eligibility quizzes.
- If eligible, complete the Boorda Scholarship Application through the online scholarship system.
- Official transcript through the student’s seventh semester; transcript should also include high school class ranking provided by the school.
- One letter of recommendation from a person in a leadership position who knows you well (e.g. teacher, principal, guidance counselor) should be submitted through the online system. This letter should not come from family members.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Additional information that has not been requested will not be accepted.
- Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. There will be no exceptions.**

Online application must be complete and submitted by **5:00 p.m., Monday, March 1st, 2022**. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure the application is complete and all materials are received on or before the deadline.
