



COVID-19 Lunch Procedures

New Lunchroom Safety Procedures

Welcome back Blazers! For the 2020-2021 School Year Mrs. Boyd will be monitoring Lunch A and Mr. Martin will be monitoring Lunch B. If at anytime in the Cafeteria you need assistance they are the person to contact to help you.

It is important to listen each day for instructions from the Lunch Monitor, as many announcements and important information is given during the Lunch Period.

Sanitation Stations- Are located directly to the right when entering through the Scholl Center doors B. Please use the hand sanitizer upon entering the Cafeteria.

Lunch Seating. All tables have four chairs, meaning no more than four students can sit at a lunch table. Students are not permitted to sit at one table and turn to speak to students at a different table. The long white tables are to hold no more than two students seated on opposite sides. The Custodial staff has marked off unavailable seats with an X to assist in this process.

Students have chosen their assigned seats at lunch and they will have to remain at that assigned seat until further notice. Please note that this is for the health and safety of all students and staff.

Lines- Students purchasing pre-wrapped food items from the Deli or the Snack Shack should wait in line standing on the floor stickers that are marked off six feet apart to ensure social distancing. If no stickers are available to stand on please wait at your table for the line to diminish before joining.



Soap and Water

Wash your hands for at least 30 seconds after using the washroom.

This is the best way to maintain distancing.



Stay Healthy

Create a Healthy Habits routine!

1. Entering the Cafeteria

- Students will enter through Scholl Center Doors B facing the main building
- Students should be sure to sanitize their hands upon entering AND choose to wash their hands in the bathroom before eating.
- Students must have their masks over their nose and mouth until they sit down to eat.

2. Prepping to eat

- Students who are purchasing food items from the Deli or Snack Shack MUST social distance with a mask ON by standing on the footprints on the floor. If no line footprints are available they must wait at their assigned table until space opens up.
- Students who wish to use the microwave, must wait for availability at their seats.
- Students may remove their mask while eating and should remain at their assigned seat until dismissed.

3. While at Your Seat:

- Do NOT turn to talk to other students
- DO NOT leave your seat without permission

4. Exiting the Lunch Room:

- Lunch A Only
 - Wait to be DISMISSED by ROW to enter the gym. Each table will sit in an assigned a section in the gym.
 - Students should proceed to their section and wait six feet apart for dismissal
 - After dismissal use the sanitation station as you exit out Scholl Center Door B1
- All Lunches
 - DO NOT STOP! Proceed to the exit without delay to your next class.
