### Scholarship Application Overview 2019

Michigan City Indiana Community Scholarship Foundation, Inc., (MCICSF, Inc.) student scholarships are awarded on the basis of merit, financial need and proven and projected ability to achieve goals; first-time high school applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. Scholarships are provided to undergraduate students who carry a full academic load, i.e., a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester or quarter, or who are in compliance with the full-time status requirement(s) of the institution being attended. Eligibility for funding requires proof of maintaining full-time enrollment and satisfactory grades.

Each applicant is evaluated individually. Scholarship amounts are based on funds available, the merit of the application and the number of students who apply. A scholarship one year does not guarantee future scholarships.

- **Applications must be renewed each year:** Applicants must provide **all** information requested legibly, i.e., typed or clearly printed.

### **Application Requirements Checklist**

1. \_\_\_\_ The proper application form must be submitted for a 2019 student already attending college and who has never applied for MCICSF, Inc. scholarship, or, who has applied but never received funds.
2. \_\_\_\_ Applicant's Projected Annual Budget Statement Form.
3. \_\_\_\_ Extra-Curricular Activities Form must be completed.
4. \_\_\_\_ An essay of approximately 300 words is required focusing on how your personal activities and interests match your educational and professional goals. **The quality of this essay is of special significance to the Foundation members evaluating your scholarship application; both content and quality are considered major factors for being awarded a Foundation Scholarship.** (This is required for all first-time applicants only.)
5. \_\_\_\_ A seven semester transcript must be included. **TRANSCRIPTS MUST HAVE AN OFFICIAL SEAL AND BE IN AN OFFICIALLY SEALED ENVELOPE OF THE MOST RECENT HIGH SCHOOL ATTENDED.** No other document will be accepted. Failure to submit will cause your application to be denied.
