Virtual Learning will follow the outline and guidance below:

- Attendance: Students will need to be present during each class period in Zoom, and participate in any necessary virtual discussions, group work, etc. Monday - Thursday: Attendance will be taken each period, just as it is in the classroom. Friday ONLY - Students will check in via email, by 9am, with their 4th Hour Teacher.
- FACTS will remain updated with class lesson plans and grades.
- Face-to-face instruction time with Zoom, Pre-Recorded Instructional Videos, and Google Hangouts will be used to deliver curriculum.
- Group activities & discussions will be facilitated through the use of Zoom, Google Hangouts, See Saw, and other various applications
- Assignments will be issued and turned in using Google Classroom
- Like college, when a student is not in a live class they should be utilizing their time for independent study and work, follow-up or meeting with teachers, group work, assignments, etc.
- Student and Academic Handbooks, as well as the iPad Responsible Use Policy will continue to apply during Virtual Learning.
